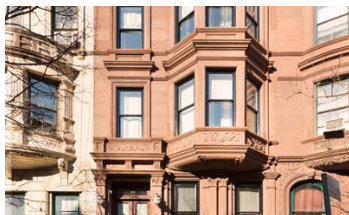

Description: Upon entering 29 West 75th Street, one immediately feels the grandeur of the space and the quality and attention to detail present in the impeccable renovation of this Upper West Side mansion. Designed by the architect George M. Walgrove in the Renaissance Revival Style and constructed in 1892 with a brownstone facade and a metal cornice, the townhouse contains approximately 9,800 square feet of interior space spread across six floors.
