Description: Located on one of Manhattan's best townhouse blocks, The Otto Dommerich Mansion stands as one of the most significant mansions on the Upper East Side. At a palatial 44 feet in width with 104 feet in depth on the lower and entry floors and 70 feet deep on the second through fifth floors, the house is characterized by exceptional scale, volume and light. Only 11 mansions on the Upper East Side are 44 feet wide or wider and none other is available for sale today. Designed by Henry C. Pelton and completed in 1917, the home offers 21,070 square feet of interior space across 7 above-grade stories, a 5,040 square foot basement with 15 foot ceilings as well as 3,350 square feet of exterior space comprising a second floor terrace, solarium terrace and a rooftop terrace with views of Park Avenue to the east and Fifth Avenue and Central Park to the west. The home boasts a stunning neo-French classic limestone faade accented by 14 windows and a dramatic double front door. Three of these windows, located on the parlor floor, rise floor-to-ceiling and open onto stone Juliet balconies. Inside, a spectacular curved staircase ascends to all levels of the home. On the seventh floor ceiling, a stunning stained glass dome provides glorious interior illumination.
